The chairman of our college gave a good message to the students, “Ultraviolet radiation not only affects humans, but wildlife as well. Excessive UV-B inhibits the growth processes of almost all green plants. There is concern that ozone depletion may lead to a loss of plant species and reduce global food supply. Make sure that old refrigerators and air conditioners are disposed of safely by giving them to a recycling yard.”

Principal of the college interacted with the students and spoke about threats to the environment due to depletion of Ozone layer. And also he explained the main cause for the depletion of ozone is determined as excessive release of chlorine and bromine from man-made compounds such as chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs), which are releasing from refrigerators, Air conditioning, Aerosol spray cans etc.

He suggested reduce the consumption of refrigerators, Air conditioning, and Aerosol spray cans etc.
