EXAMINATIONS PROCEDURES

1. PURPOSE

RISE Krishna Sai Prakasam Group of Institutions, is certified by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi, is affiliated to Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University (JNTUK), Kakinada, and is recognised by the Government of Andhra Pradesh. Exams are a crucial part of determining whether or not students have achieved the course objectives. Objective-based education (OBE) is the driving force behind the Institute's examination procedure.

STATEMENT

Set up an assessment system that is fair and transparent, so that the quality of education may be improved.

SCOPE

Quality teaching and learning activities are assessed using the OBE method. As a result, the test is still an essential instrument for evaluating students. JNTU regulates the Semester End Examination (SEE) as a form of Formative Assessment (FA) and Summative Assessment (SA) in the form of Internal Assessment (IA).

PROCEDURES

In accordance with OBE requirements, the institute uses the following two types of assessment tools:

- a.Internal assessment exams and assignments are included in the form of a formative assessment. The quality of the evaluation is monitored by IQAC.
- b. The Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University (JNTU) mandates that students take the Semester End Exam (SEE).

Examination Section Committee has created an Internal Assessment Test schedule that each department's Internal Assessment committee is responsible for implementing in accordance with the JNTUK academic calendar.

Exams Monitoring Committee announces the SEE timetable for both UG and PG programmes to all stakeholders.

JNTUK's SEE rules and regulations are briefed to students by concerned department heads.

SEE are administered by the Chief Superintendent and the Examination Section (internal and external) in accordance with JNTU regulations.

One descriptive and one objective exam are included in the Formative assessment.

For the internal exams, two set of question papers will be set by the appropriate teacher and on the day of Exam, the Exam Section will select any one of the Set.

The JNTU will use the platform to administer the objective test, which will be administered online.
