POLICY ON ADMISSION

1. PURPOSE:

According to the policy, a framework for admissions and procedures to be followed for admissions is established. The policy also provides a brief overview of the admission procedure for UG and PG programmes at the RISE Krishna Sai Prakasam Group of Institutions, which is affiliated to the Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University (JNTUK), Kakinada.

2. SCOPE:

All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi has authorized RISE Krishna Sai Prakasam Group of Institutions as a self-funded institute, affiliated to Jawaharlal Technological University (JNTUK), Kakinada, and recognized by the Government of Andhra Pradesh. In accordance with the standards established by AICTE and the affiliating university, students can be accepted to the first year of UG courses (BTech), the second year of UG courses (Lateral entrance), and the first year of PG programmes (M. Tech., MCA, and MBA).

4. ADMISSION NOTIFICATION

(a) UG courses

APSCHE releases the notice to conduct the entrance test (Common Entrance Test - CET - APEAMCET for 1st year B.Tech and APECET for Lateral Entry) as per the Government of Andhra Pradesh and AICTE admission and eligibility requirements.

(b) PG courses

According to the admission and eligibility criteria established by the Government of Andhra Pradesh and the AICTE, the Andhra Pradesh State Common Entrance Test (PGECET) for M.Tech and the Andhra Pradesh State Common Entrance Test (APICET) for MBA and MCA is conducted by the APSCHE.

5. ADMISSION PROCESS FOR UG AND PG COURSES

- CET QUOTA: Based on the results of the APEAMCET, APECET, APICET, and PGECET, the APSCHE commences the admission process by providing an official counseling notification that includes all necessary instructions.
- MANAGEMENT QUOTA: Students can approach the institute with a valid score card of any qualifying entrance test or Direct admissions based on the pre qualified Eligibility for admission via management quota.
- The Institute verifies the required documents given by students in order to confirm their enrollment; after that, the Affiliating University confirms the allotment and issues a Registration Number to each student in the programme.
