1. PURPOSE:

The RISE Krishna Sai Prakasam Group of Institutions is dedicated to provide high-quality education at a reasonable price to its students. It would provide assistance to students who achieve success in academics, athletics, and cultural activities, as well as in other areas that merit commendation. It is also devoted to providing assistance to students who belongs to Economically Weaker Section and Meritorious.

SCOPE:

The RISE Krishna Sai Prakasam Group of Institutions is devoted to provide students from a variety of socio-economic, cultural, and religious backgrounds with a comprehensive level of higher education at a reasonable cost. The institute's policy strives to give students with the required support through a well-structured process. It is the purpose of this policy brief to provide a framework for the financial assistance provided to deserving UG and PG students, as well as students who excel exceptionally in sports and cultural domains, as well as students who require special consideration because they belong to deprived socio-economic groups and economically disadvantaged sections.

2. POLICY:

Eligibility:

1. Students who have achieved high CET scores and who come from economically Disadvantaged backgrounds are eligible to apply.
2. Pre-qualifying students who have achieved the best results possible in their Examinations.
3. Students with a single mother.
4. Sports and culturally talented students

Application and Approval:

1. With the support of the college's scholarships department, students who have a White Ration Card and have a good CET score must apply via the Government Portal.
2. Students who wish to apply for additional scholarships should do so in writing to the College's Finance Committee, addressed to the Management.
3. All applications for free ships will be reviewed and verified by the Finance Committee at the end of the admissions process before being sent to the College Management for consideration.
4. The College Management makes individual choices based on the recommendations of the Finance Committee and accepts them.
5. The Management's Concession is valid for the duration of the course.
